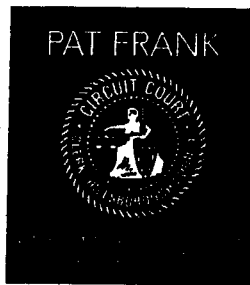

STAFF'S RECOMMENDED BOARD MOTION

Establish the Spring Lake Community Development District (CDD) in accordance with the attached ordinance subject to any changes by the County Attorney's Office.

FINANCIAL IMPACT STATEMENT

No direct financial impact to the County will occur as a result of this petition. Of the total \$44,428,160 of estimated eligible infrastructure costs, 62% (\$27,458,160) is expected to be funded directly by the developer through sources that include, but not limited to, equity financing, conventional bank financing or short term bond debt issued by the district. The remaining 38% (\$16,970,000) of the estimated eligible infrastructure costs will be funded by the issuance of long-term district bonds that will be paid with annual homeowner assessments of \$600 for townhomes, \$1,200 for 40 foot single family residences, \$1,500 for 50 foot single family residences, and \$1,800 for 60 foot single family residences. The \$16,970,000 estimated par value bonds are composed of the construction fund, capitalized interest, debt service reserve fund, cost of issuance and underwriter's discount. The proposed development consists of 445 multi-family townhomes and 689 single family homes on lots ranging from 40 to 60 feet in width.

BACKGROUND

On October 18, 2006, Metro Development Group, Inc., petitioned Hillsborough County to establish the Spring Lake Community Development District. The authorized agent is Mark K. Straley of Straley Robin & Williams Law Firm. The 339-acre site is generally located north of Big Bend Road and east of Highway 301. The Spring Lake CDD is a residential Planned Development containing 445 multi-family townhomes and 689 single family homes on lots ranging from 40 to 60 feet in width. The property is currently vacant and unimproved. The proposed development is consistent with the Planned Development approval Resolution #04-1593.

The total infrastructure cost estimate for the Spring Lake Community Development District is \$44,428,160 (see Proposed Acquisition and Construction Cost Estimates and Time Table listed below) and includes stormwater management, district roads and street lights, sanitary sewer and water facilities, off site improvements, landscape and hardscape, recreation facilities, professional fees, permits, and underwriting costs. The development of Spring Lake is projected to occur as four phases over an estimated three (3) year period from 2007 to 2009.

ORDINANCE NO. 07-1

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SPRING LAKE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 190, FLORIDA STATUTES; SPECIFYING GENERAL AND SPECIAL POWERS OF THE DISTRICT; DESCRIBING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE DISTRICT; NAMING THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS; PROVIDING FOR THE ADMINISTRATION AND FINANCING OF THE DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Metro Development Group, LLC, a Florida limited liability company, ("Petitioner") has filed a Petition with Hillsborough County requesting that the Board of County Commissioners of Hillsborough County ("County") adopt an ordinance establishing the Spring Lake Community Development District pursuant to Chapter 190, Fla. Stat. ("District"), and designating the real property described in Exhibit A, attached hereto, as the area of land for which the District is authorized to manage and finance basic service delivery; and

WHEREAS, the District will constitute a timely, efficient, effective, responsive and economic method of delivering community development services in the area described in Exhibit A, which the County is not able to provide at a level and quality needed to service the District, thereby providing a solution to the County's planning, management and financing needs for the delivery of capital infrastructure therein without overburdening the County and its taxpayers; and

WHEREAS, the County has held a public hearing on the Petition in accordance with the requirements and procedures of Section 190.005 (1) (d), Fla. Stat.; and

WHEREAS, the County has considered the record of the public hearing and the factors set forth in Section 190.005 (1) (e), Fla. Stat.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HILLSBOROUGH COUNTY, FLORIDA THIS 23rd DAY OF January, 2007 AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. FINDINGS OF FACT. The County hereby finds and states that:

1. the "WHEREAS" clauses stated above are adopted as findings of fact in support of this Ordinance;
2. all statements contained in the Petition are true and correct;
3. the creation of the District is not inconsistent with any applicable element or portion of the State Comprehensive Plan or the County's Comprehensive Plan;
4. the area of land within the proposed District is of sufficient size, is sufficiently compact and is sufficiently contiguous to be developable as one functional interrelated community;
5. the creation of the District is the best alternative available for delivering community development services and facilities to the area that will be served by the District;

6. the proposed community development services and facilities to be provided by the District will not be incompatible with the capacity and uses of existing local and regional community development services and facilities; and

7. the area that will be served by the District is amenable to separate, special-district government.

SECTION 2. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW.

1. This proceeding is governed by Chapter 190, Fla. Stat.;
2. The County has jurisdiction pursuant to Section 190.005 (2), Fla. Stat.; and
3. The granting of the Petition complies with the dictates of Chapter 190, Fla. Stat.

SECTION 3. CREATION, BOUNDARIES AND POWERS. There is hereby created the Spring Lake Community Development District for the area of land described in Exhibit A, attached hereto, which shall exercise the powers of Sections 190.011 and 190.012 (1), (2) (a)-(d) and (f), and (3), Fla. Stat., and which shall operate in accordance with the uniform community development district charter as set forth in Sections 190.006-190.041, Fla. Stat., including the special powers provided by Section 190.012, Fla. Stat.

SECTION 4. INITIAL BOARD. The following five persons are designated as the initial members of the Board of Supervisors: Michael Lawson, Greg Singleton, William Eshenbaugh, Patricia Ryan, and Henry Moorehead.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon receipt of acknowledgment that a copy of this Ordinance has been filed with the Secretary of State.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, provision, or other part of this Ordinance is held invalid for any reason, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby, but shall remain in full force and effect.

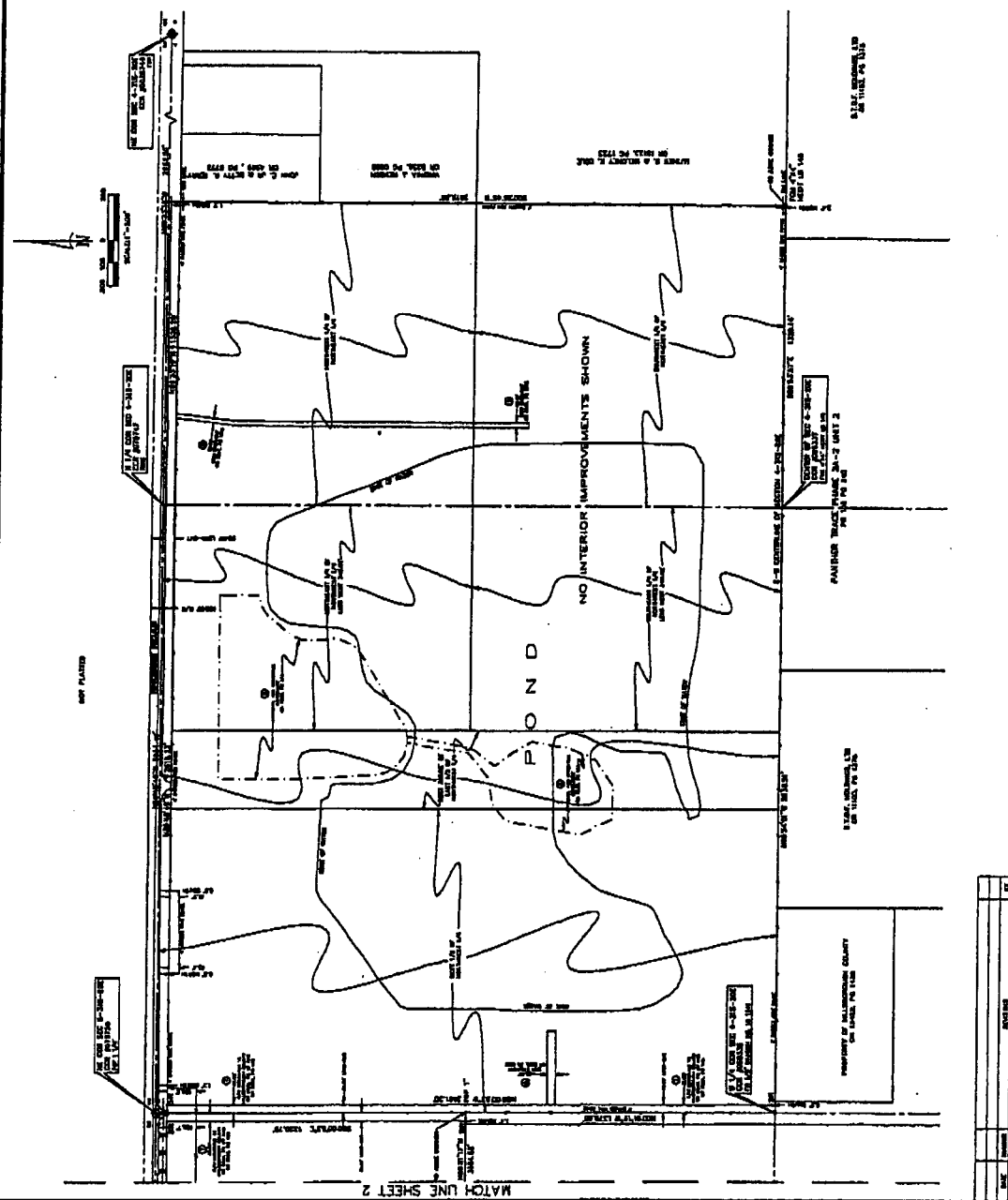

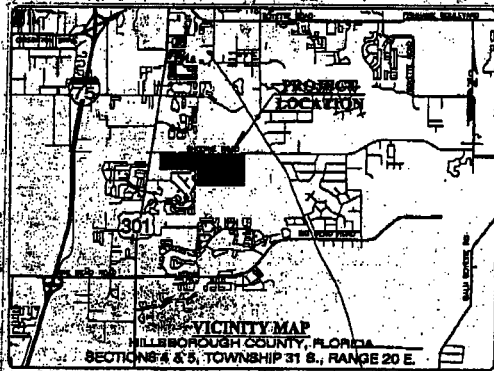

In compliance with the provisions of Chapter 190, Florida Statutes, a public hearing will be held by the Hillsborough County Board of County Commissioners beginning at 1:30 p.m., Tuesday, January 23, 2007, in the Boardroom in the Frederick B. 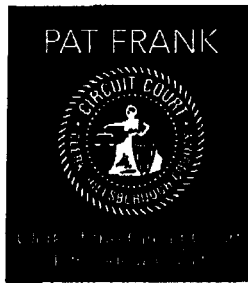
AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SPRING LAKE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 190, FLORIDA STATUTES; NAMING THE DISTRICT; DESCRIBING THE EXTERNAL BOUNDARIES OF THE DISTRICT; DESCRIBING THE FUNCTIONS AND POWERS OF THE DISTRICT; DESIGNATING FIVE PERSONS TO SERVE AS THE INITIAL MEMBERS OF THE DISTRICTS BOARD OF SUPERVISORS; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

The proposed Community Development District is comprised of approximately 279 acres, located in unincorporated Hillsborough County, just south of Rhodine Road, north of Big Bend Road and east of U.S. Hwy. 301. The petitioner has proposed to establish the Spring Lake Community Development District to plan, finance, acquire, construct, operate and maintain all infrastructure and community facilities, which may be authorized by such districts under Florida law, including but not limited to water management and control, water supply, sewer, wastewater management, bridges or culverts, roads and street lights, parks and recreational facilities, security facilities, mosquito control and certain other projects when expressly approved or required by a local government and any other facilities in accordance with Section 190.012, Florida Statutes.

Copies of the petition, the proposed ordinance and department reports are open to public inspection at the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of Hillsborough County, 601 E. Kennedy Blvd., 12th Floor, Tampa, Florida 33602. All interested persons and affected units of general - purpose local government shall be given an opportunity to appear at the hearing and present oral or written comments on the petition. Any person or affected unit of general - purpose local government, who wishes to appeal any decision made by the Board with respect to any matter considered at this public hearing will need a record of the proceedings. For that purpose the person or unit of general - purpose local government may need to insure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made that includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.

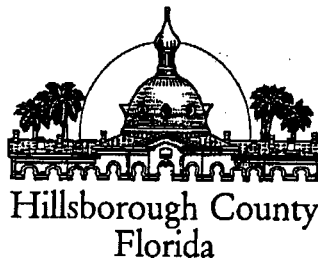


